KENDALL COUNTY ELDERLY AND DISABLED VOTERS

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist elderly and handicapped voters in the General Primary Election, March 17, 2026:

AUTOMARK: Allows handicapped and elderly voters to vote independently and in private with this ballot marking device.

MAGNIFIERS: To assist voters who have visual problems.

HANDICAPPED VOTING BOOTH: For voters who must vote from a seated position.

VOTING ASSISTANCE: Handicapped and Elderly voters requiring help may be assisted by a friend, relative or by the Election Judges.

CURBSIDE VOTING: Available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Call the Kendall County Voter Registration Office at 630-553-4105 for information.

VOTER REGISTRATION: Call the Kendall County Voter Registration Office at 630-553-4105 for locations throughout the county for the Registrar nearest you, or if special arrangements need to be made.

VOTE BY MAIL: Voters who wish to cast a Vote by Mail Ballot may contact the Kendall County Voter Registration Office 630-553-4105 to obtain the necessary forms.

EARLY VOTING: Voters may contact the Kendall County Voter Registration Office 630-553-4105 to receive directions and hours of the Early Voting locations if voting in person.
