WHEREAS, subject to the overall administrative authority of the Illinois Supreme Court set forth in Supreme Court Rule 21, and pursuant to the specific authority granted by Local Rules 1.0(B) and 1.20(A), the Chief Judge may enter or amend Administrative/General Orders of the 23rd Judicial Circuit in the exercise of his or general authority.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Rule 1.20(A), the Chief Judge is specifically authorized to appoint Presiding Judges, and pursuant to Local Rule 1.20(C), the Chief Judge shall automatically serve as the Presiding Judge in the county in which he or she is assigned to hear cases on a regular basis.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Honorable Bradley J. Waller is appointed Presiding Judge of Dekalb County and the Honorable Stephen L. Krentz shall continue to serve as Presiding Judge of Kendall County, until such time as their successors are appointed.
