Call For Projects
2026

Kendall County is excited to announce another round of funding availability in 2026 for the Transportation Alternatives Program. For 2026, there is only about \$50,000 available in unobligated funding for this Program, as the Kendall County Board recently approved another \$103,000 for the Hoover to Fox River Bluffs Trail... which is now under construction.

As you may remember, \$150,000 is now annually deposited in the TAP Fund. Additionally, TAP rules have changed. Upper limits of funding have increased, and maintenance projects are now eligible. Details of the changes and the history of the TAP Fund are enclosed.

If you have potential projects, please submit applications by December 31, 2025 to be eligible for these funds. Remember, projects can now be funded up to 75% with TAP Funds; and project funding limits have increased to \$100,000 per project. Don't forget that projects must be located along State or County Highways in Kendall County.
