

SOLICITOR

A solicitor's permit is required by the County of Kendall for any person, firm or corporation to go in or upon any private residence, farm or premises in the unincorporated portions of the County for (i) seeking to obtain orders of purchase of goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, real property or personal property or services of any kind. (ii) seeking to obtain prospective customers for application or purchase of insurance of any kind, or (iii) Seeking to obtain subscriptions to books, magazines, periodicals, newspapers, and every other type or kind of publication.

Solicitation shall be permitted Monday through Saturday between 9:00 am and 7:00 pm. Permit is valid for up to one year.

The license shall be carried at all times and shall be exhibited by the applicant whenever he or she is requested to do so by any person solicited or by any police officer.

Notice of refusal of invitation to solicitors shall be a 3" x 4" card exhibited upon or near the main entrance door to the premise, indicating substantially the applicable words as follows: "No Soliciting", "No Solicitors" or "No Solicitors Invited"

Kendall County residents are urged to exercise caution when interacting with door-to-door solicitors. If anyone comes to your door that is unable to provide a valid permit, please contact the Kendall County Sheriff's Office at 630-553-7500.
